NOTICE OF HEARING AND OBJECTION DEADLINE ON:

- (1) **MOTION FOR ORDER ESTABLISHING BIDDING PROCEDURES IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE OF SUBSTANTIALLY ALL OF THE DEBTOR’S ASSETS;**
- (2) **DEBTOR’S EXPEDITED MOTION FOR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER TO LIMIT NUMBER OF RECIPIENTS OF FUTURE NOTICES;**
- (3) **DEBTOR’S MOTION FOR ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 105(a) AUTHORIZING THE DEBTOR TO (1) MAINTAIN ITS EXISTING CASH MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AND (2) MAINTAIN ITS BANK ACCOUNTS; AND**
- (4) **DEBTOR’S MOTION FOR EXPEDITED HEARING ON EMERGENCY MOTION FOR THE ENTRY OF INTERIM AND FINAL ORDERS PURSUANT TO SECTION 364 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE AUTHORIZING THE DEBTOR TO OBTAIN DEBTOR-IN-POSSESSION FINANCING.**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on April 2-3, 2008, JoAnne’s Bed & Back Stores, Inc. (the “Debtor”), filed the above motions (together, the “Motions”). On April 2-3, 2008, the Debtor also filed motions seeking expedited hearings on the Motions (the “Expedited Hearing Motions”). On April 3, 2008, the Bankruptcy Court granted the Expedited Hearing Motions, scheduled the hearings set forth herein and established the objection deadlines set forth herein.

HEARING NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Bankruptcy Court shall conduct a hearing on the Motions on **April 9, 2008 at 10:30 a.m.** at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, 6500 Cherrywood Lane, Greenbelt, Maryland 20770 (the “Hearing”).

OBJECTION DEADLINE

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that any objection to the Motions shall be filed and served on Debtor's counsel no later than one (1) day before the Hearing.

Any such objections must be in writing and must be filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland, Office of the Clerk, 6500 Cherrywood Lane, Greenbelt, Maryland 20770 and served (by electronic case filing, deliver or mailing a copy) upon the undersigned. The objection must contain a complete specification of the factual and legal grounds upon which it is based. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED OR IF YOU FAIL TO TIMELY OBJECT, THE BANKRUPTCY COURT MAY GRANT THE RELIEF REQUESTED WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE. The Court may grant the relief requested without a hearing if the objection filed states inadequate grounds for denial.
